1. The soldier professionally wears the uniform of the day and is equipped as previously directed.
2. Self explanatory.
3. Proper, sharp, crisp movements bringing vehicles/pedestrians to sentry for ID check.
4. Left hand/arm designating stop point.
5. EX: Good morning (state rank, if officer or civilian, sir/ma'am), may I see a picture identification please.
6. After ID is checked ok for an officer, a salute is smartly rendered and a courtesy is rendered, EX: "thank you sir, you may pass".
7. EX: "thank you, (state rank or sir/ma'am), you may pass." Proper arm and hand signal, crisply executed.
8. Trainer establishes the conditions and Special Orders.
